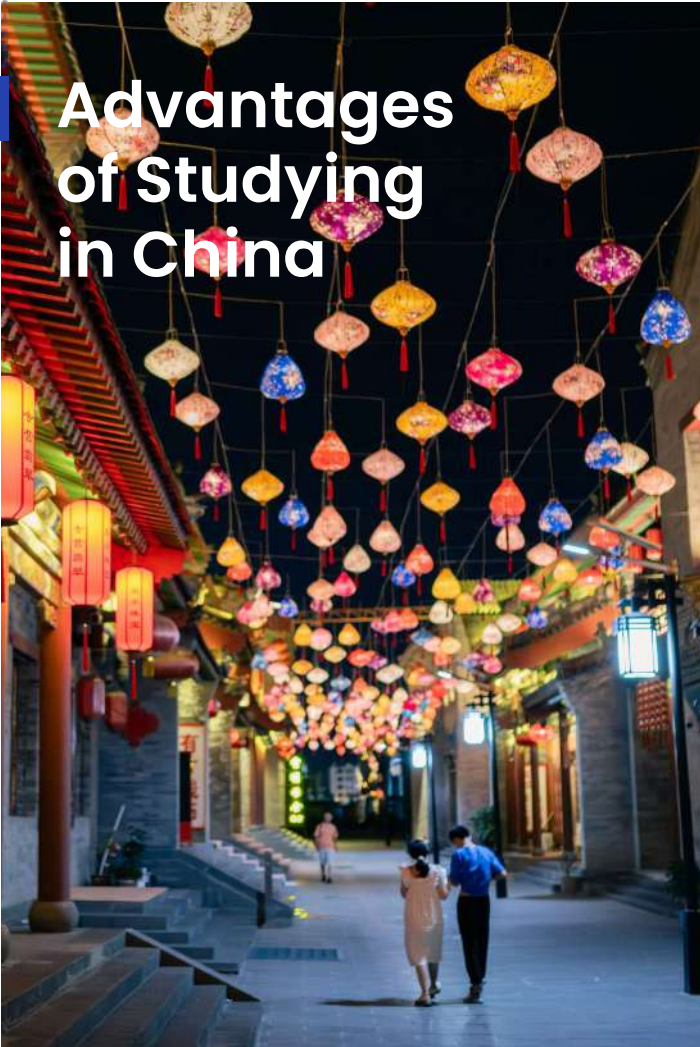

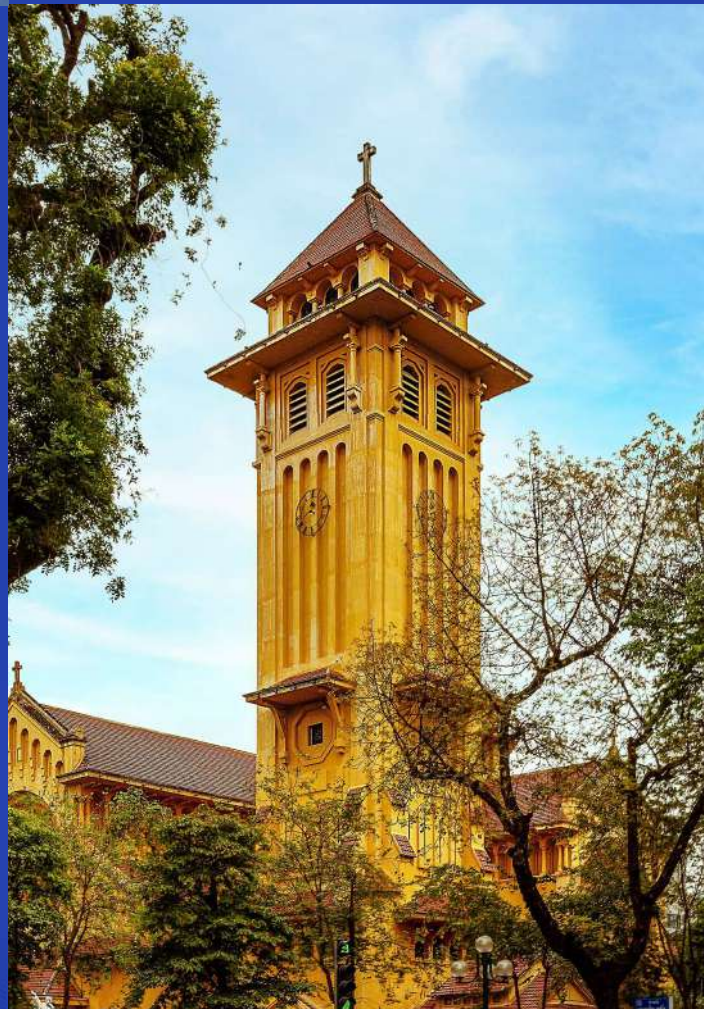

Overview of Chinese Education System

Overview of Chinese Education System

China implements a universal education system across the country, covering primary, secondary, and higher education.

Pre-school education

Pre-school education refers to education targeted at children aged from 3 to 6 in kindergarten.

Primary education

Primary education refers to education targeted at children aged from 6 to 12 in primary school.

Secondary education

Secondary education refers to education targeted at youth aged from 12 to 17 in middle school, including 3 years in junior middle school and 3 years in senior middle school.



In addition to commonly-used international university rankings (such as QS World University Rankings and THE World University Rankings), Chinese universities have their own classification systems as follows:

C9 League (College of 9)

Universities under Project 985:

C9 League consists of top nine Chinese universities. Launched in October 2009, it is the first union of such kind in China. All of the nine universities are included in first list of 985 Project, which are Peking University, Tsinghua University, Harbin Institute of Technology, Fudan University, Shanghai Jiao Tong University, Nanjing University, Zhejiang University, University of Science and Technology of China, and Xi'an Jiaotong University.

Pre-school education

Universities under Project 211:

It is an educational project approved by the State Council of the People's Republic of China, with the aim of building a number of universities and key disciplines for the development in the 21st century. There are 112 universities under this project as of 2011.

Higher education refers to the stage after secondary education. Technically, China's higher education can be divided into education in junior colleges, undergraduate programs, and postgraduate/doctoral programs. Junior colleges make up the primary level of higher education, which can be classified in three categories: higher vocational colleges, higher specialized colleges and vocational colleges affiliated to universities. Students graduate from junior colleges will receive graduation certificate, but no degree certificate will be awarded. China's degree awarding system starts from undergraduate (bachelor). Undergraduate program takes the middle level of higher education.

Postgraduate/doctoral program is the top level of higher education, with the objective of conducting academic research. It is worth noting that the post-doctoral stage will not be awarded with another degree; it refers to the stage of engaging in research for a certain period of time in institutions of higher learning or research institutions. Therefore, the doctoral degree is the highest academic degree in China.

Tianjin University

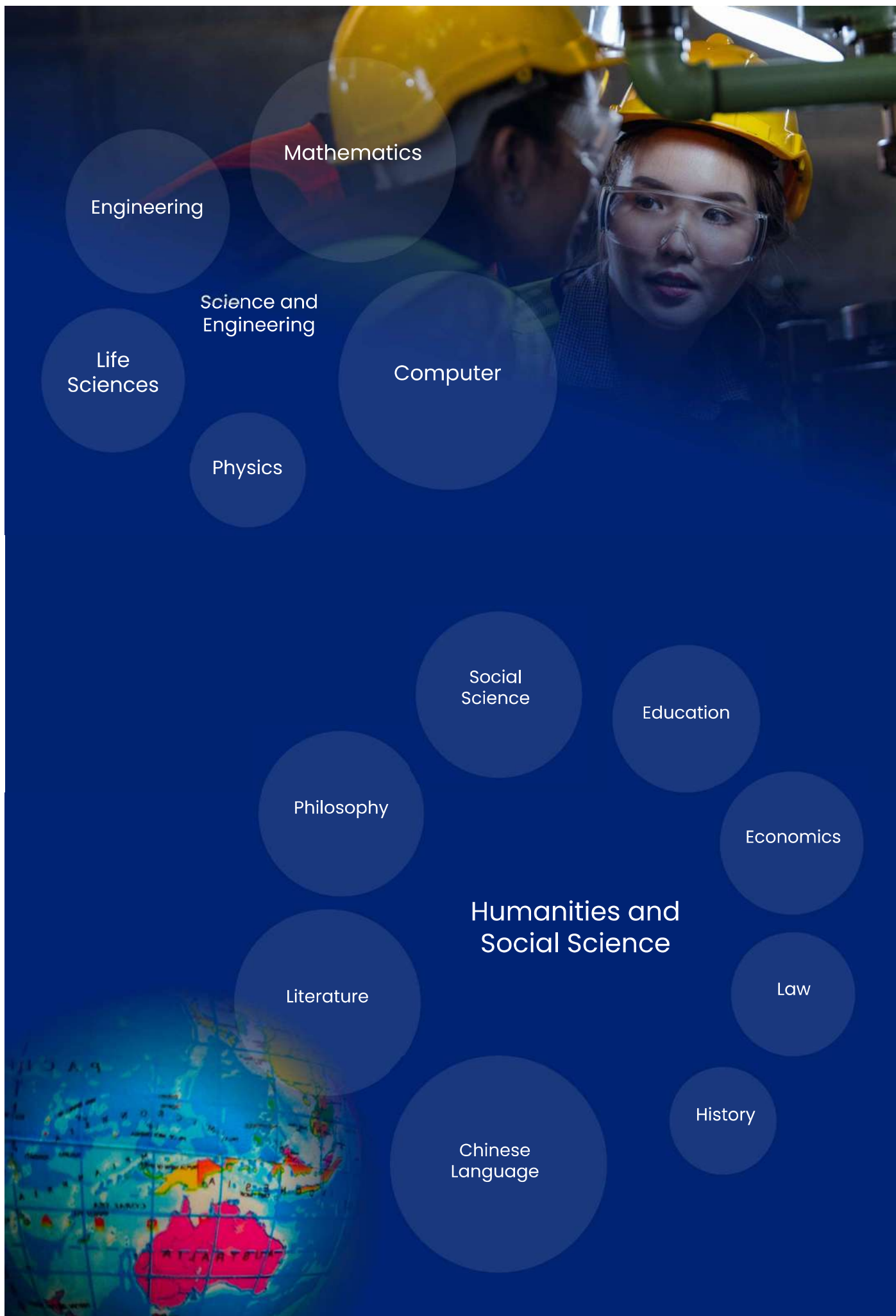
